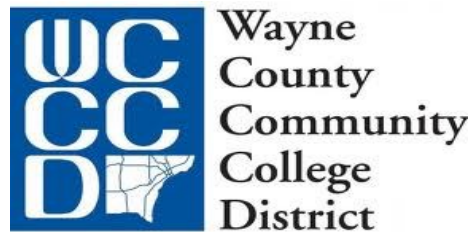

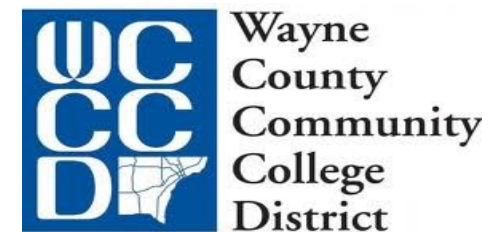

DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAM

- The Dual Enrollment Program began in 2009.
- Students can participate during summer at the end of their 9th grade year.
- Each grade level has enrollment for only 25 students and its based on a first come first serve system.
- Dual Enrollment is a **3-or 4 credit, optional program for 10th -12th grade students.**
- Classes are offered during the Fall and Spring after-school and during the Summer .
- Students who opted to be in this program must maintain a high school 3.0 GPA or higher, **must attend** all college classes on their scheduled days and times.
- Parents and students **must sign an academic agreement** that states in part, “if my child receives a “D” in any class during the program, my **child can not re-enroll in the program.**
- Students **can not participate** in any activities that **conflict** with days and times for dual enrollment.
- 3 unexcused absences or 3 instances of tardiness will result in a student being dropped from the program.
- 2016 was our first graduation class of four Seniors receiving both a high school diploma and an associate’s degree.
