## Post-Dismissal Activities Policies

Chandler Park Academy School District (CPA) recognizes that post-dismissal (after-school) activities are a necessary part of the life of a healthy, effective educational setting. Because after-school activities often are not structured in the same way as the regular school day, these policies are in place to ensure a safe educational environment for them. ***This district policy will be enforced daily. If you have questions, please contact your school administrator.***

### General Policies:

- Students are to leave the CPA campus upon completion of their educational schedule. CPA does not provide any latch-key or other holding or supervisory service after students' educational day has ended. *The educational day includes classes and lunch periods, and, for some students, approved and supervised afterschool activities.*
- It is the policy of CPA that transportation away from the campus when afterschool activities are ended is the responsibility of parents.
- Students are not to return to the CPA campus after they have left the campus.
- Students must be picked up by parents immediately upon completion of afterschool activities. Students not picked up promptly upon completion of afterschool activities will no longer be allowed to participate in those activities.
- Students are not to loiter anywhere on the CPA campus after school and/ or after-school activities. This includes but is not limited to hallways, athletic fields, playgrounds, parking lots, walkways, bleachers, and lawns.
- Siblings who must wait for transportation from school until their siblings have completed after-school activities will be held in supervised facilities. Students are expected to report and remain in their assigned location while waiting for siblings.

## Athletics:

- All practices for all teams are closed. This means that no spectators are allowed, including but not limited to siblings, friends, or providers of transportation.
- All athletics will remain in their respective buildings until called for by their coach for the beginning of practice. They are supervised by their coaches and/or CPA security personnel.
- Each school will have a supervised holding area for athletes prior to practice.
- Procedures are in place for the students on visiting schools' teams. They are greeted, identified by their coaches and ID cards, and escorted to their locker facilities. They are supervised by their coaches and CPA locker attendants.
- Athletes' parents must provide transportation away from the CPA campus immediately after practices and games have concluded.
